CHRISTNET

CHRISTNET is a homeless shelter, held right here in our Trenton Rd building, from January 21st to 28th, 2018. Many volunteers are needed for this ministry, so we can provide the homeless in the Downriver area with a safe place to spend the night and 3 meals a day during our host week. There will be sign-up posters for shift work and food/supplies at both campuses this year; outside the Cana Room in the West Gallery, as in years past. The other location will be on a table just outside the Sanctuary at the PA Rd. Campus. There are 3 shifts that need volunteers: the 6 to 11pm shift handles arrival, dinner, showers and bedtime. The 11pm to 4am shift prepares lunches and monitors the sleeping areas. The 4 to 7am shift prepares breakfast, sees the guests off and cleans areas used for the day school. At least 1 male and 1 female must be present on each shift. Please help those less fortunate by signing up for one or more shifts and please keep ChristNet in your prayers.
