not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." (Matthew 6:19-21)

The seminary class that I just finished was all about distinctions. The distinction between Law and Gospel, the distinction between the two kinds of righteousness, the distinction between the two kingdoms, etc. What I learned over the course of that class is that you can almost never put something wholly into one category. And isn't that just like our daily lives? Things are rarely all black and white. Most things fall into the gray. For example, a statement might be made in a sermon that speaks good news for one person, but for the person right next to them might be devastating and offensive. So what are we supposed to do with that? God's Word is living and active. This means that when we read our Bibles and hear God's Word preached in a sermon that I will read and hear what God needs me to read and hear. God is actively working through His Word, all for the purpose of my salvation. What a mighty God we serve!

SMP Program Update: My 5th class is officially complete and now I am getting ready for my summer class that will be on site at the seminary in St. Louis at the end of June. The summer class is a preaching class. As always, I thank you for your constant support and prayers. Each class, so far, has been enriching and immediately applicable to our church here at CTK, which has been great! I can't wait to see what the rest of the classes entail!







I'm just helping a fellow Christian by providing a caring, listening, confidential ear in a way Jesus would approve.




Day School News





VICAR'S MESSAGE

Summer is finally here! What a blessing our Michigan summers are. Recently in Wednesday morning men's Bible study, we read a few verses out of Acts chapter 2 where Luke is describing the early church. He says that those in the early church, led by the apostles, "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers..." and then a few verses later they were "praising God and having favor with all the people." This last line stuck out like a sore thumb and it was the one that our



group talked about. "Having favor with all the people." There is a difficult balance to maintain in a confessional church body like ours between speaking the truth about what the Bible says and what we believe against showing God's love to our neighbor. In fact, we know that telling someone the truth and loving them are not opposites; sometimes you show love by telling someone the truth, even if it is uncomfortable. And yet, what is the charge that our culture brings against the church? That the church, and God by extension, is not tolerant. The focus is on what the church is against, not what the church is for. Maybe that is because even asking what the church stands for is still not the right question. This summer, as we go about our schedules, our vacations, and our backyard BBQ's, I encourage you to remember not "what do I stand for?" but instead "who stands for me?" Regardless of what my neighbor believes or doesn't, my calling is to love them, because Jesus loved me first. How can I go out of my way to make sure they know that I love them? I pray that God will help us all to be a candle in the dark for our culture and our neighbors. May God bless you this June and always!
