

A Note from Vicar PJ Brooks


VICAR

This year's school theme verse is Joshua 1:9, "Have I not commanded you? Be

strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for Yahweh your God will be with you wherever you go." Joshua is the brand new leader of God's people after Moses has been at the helm for 40 years. God's people are about to face a whole new set of problems and challenges as they encounter enemies in the promised land. Notice that God's encouragement for Joshua is not based on the fact that Joshua has been training for this moment, or that Joshua is the perfect man for this job, or even that Joshua is a good leader and will be able to persevere. Instead, God simply reminds Joshua that He will never leave or abandon His people. And because of Jesus, we too have God with us wherever we go. We don't have to be afraid, because He is our strength and our courage; Yahweh our God is with us wherever we go!

YOUR CTK FOOD PANTRY

I am now looking at the statistics for July that were submitted to Gleaners Food Bank. In July we helped, with God's and your help, 211 families representing 597 individuals. It is amazing what God's love accomplishes!

We are still using the very workable drive-thru method at Pennsylvania Rd. This allows us a number of stations to hand out a variety of fruits and vegetables. Using carts, we wheel additional "non-perishable" food out to the curb. We also include from Meijer Simply Give gift card purchases of milk, bread, cheese, margarine, and eggs.

Much also goes on behind the scenes. There are weekly Meijer "shoppers," a Wednesday truck pick-up and unloading from Gleaners, and organization/stocking of food delivered from Gleaners intended for Thursday distribution. Distribution is on Thursdays from 3:00-3:45 p.m.

Thanks to the Kiwanis for their much-appreciated donations of food items and kits. They've already been given out.

We certainly have a responsible, happy group of volunteers. Thank you, Jesus and CTK!



By now, you probably have heard that we are moving our Sunday morning worship and all Bible Class and Sunday School (including confirmation and early communion classes) to our Trenton Rd. Campus, beginning Sunday Oct. 1st. All times will remain the same; 9am and 11am worship, with Bible Class/Sunday School at 10am. More details will be presented at a town hall meeting on Thursday, Sept. 7 at 7pm in the West Gallery, including the unique opportunity we have to help a fellow Christian church, Gilead Baptist, in the midst of their relocation. I'll save the details for that meeting. I want to take this opportunity to assure everyone that, even though our Sunday mornings are moving to the Trenton Rd. Campus, both the Penn Rd. and Trenton Rd. campuses remain vital parts of our ministry to the Gospel. We purchased the Penn. Rd. campus with the goal of moving all ministries there.
