

Last week, on a Thursday afternoon, I was spending some time teaching with our 6th graders here at CTK. Before the class session started, I overheard a conversation between two students. They were talking about the progress that they had made in reading through the whole Bible. You







Pastor's Message

On June 9th, PJ Brooks will be ordained and installed as a Pastor at Christ The King Lutheran Church. It is a very special event for CTK and for Vicar Brooks. CTK is blessed that God has called PJ into the ministry, and we are so thankful for his enthusiasm to serve in God's kingdom. As part of his classwork, PJ and I go over "homework questions" on Thursdays. These past weeks, he has been wrapping up a class on the Lutheran Confessions. These are a set of documents written in the 16th century by the Lutheran Reformers to explain what we believe. The Confessions are a uniquely "Lutheran" thing. Simply put, the Confessions are our way of saying, "This is what we believe the Bible to mean; it will not change, our teachings are tied to the Scriptures." That is why we teach the same things in 2024 as Martin Luther taught in 1529 when he wrote the Small Catechism. One of the homework questions was, "What does it mean to be confessional?" PJ and I agreed it means being Biblical. We don't think of ourselves as a confessional church, but rather a Biblical church. Nations, leaders, cultures, social dynamics all change. Some churches try to change with them, and some have sacrificed their commitment to God's Word in doing so. We will not. God's Word is timeless, active, powerful and a miracle in our lives. God's Word doesn't change. We are transformed by God's Word. On June 9th, PJ will be asked, "Do you believe the Confessions are in agreement with the one Scriptural faith?" His "I do" is not an agreement to be Lutheran, but to be Biblical. God provides faithful shepherds to serve His people and He's at it again on June 9th, a very special day indeed!
