# Pastor's Message

We're in the midst of Vacation Bible School. The theme is "Destination Creation." We're sharing the truth of God's creation, as recorded in Genesis. We pray the Holy Spirit will lead our young Christians to grow in this area of knowledge. Notice how I say "knowledge" rather than "faith." The truth of God creating the world and everything in it in six 24-hour days and the earth being about 6,000 years old is summed up in the phrase "young earth creationist." Science is on our side, and so we grow in knowledge. Evolutionists lack any scientific evidence to support their theory.



That sounds like hyperbole, like I'm exaggerating to make a point; I'm not! I can't stress this enough: evolution does not have a single piece of observational science to support species changing one to another as they increase in complexity. To believe that takes faith-childlike faith. In fact, to believe in evolution is like believing in Santa Claus! Therein lies the great irony of today's secular humanism. Our young Christians, by the grace of God, will grow up to be men and women of knowledge and faith, while those who deny God are men and women whose belief system is akin to preschoolers! That's what David meant when he said in Psalm 14, "The fool says in his heart, 'There is no God." We treasure David's words in Psalm 19, "The heavens declare the glory of God, the skies proclaim the work of his hands."
