

## This Month in CTK History



After the busy month of December, the cold and snowy month of January slowed, but some notable events happened at the beginning of the new year for CTK over the years.

First, Rev. Biesenthal was tasked with starting the "New Mission" in 1951. In 1954, CTK applied for membership in the Missouri synod. In January 1959, it was announced that the Board of Christian Education would be organized. Then in 1961, officers of the church were recognized at a special dinner for the first time. Next, we jump to 1983, when a Saturday evening worship service was added. Later, in 1995, church services were held in the gym while construction was being done on the church. Also in January 1995, many of the teachers moved their classrooms into the newly built school wing.

Finally, our history reflects several events in January at the Pennsylvania Road campus. The first Women's Bible Study took place on January 18, 2007. On January 2, 2008, the demolition of Building 5 began. Wishing everyone a Happy 2025!!

#### **YOUR FOOD PANTY**

FOOD PANTRY

God created a culinary relationship between a food-producing plant and a food-consuming humanity. Adam and Eve lived in a garden. Old Testament laws specified that harvesters leave food in the fields for the hungry to glean. The Apostle Paul took an offering from distant congregations for the poor in the Jerusalem church. Jesus fed thousands with fish and bread. Jesus commanded His followers to feed the hungry. With His help, Christ The King Church and School do that through our CTK Food Pantry.

Through the years, our congregation, our school, teachers in public schools, Gleaners food group, individuals of the community, and Meijer Corp. have been used by God to feed the hungry.

The Meijer Corp. has used the Simply Give program to generate \$97 million in food donations for the Midwest since 2008. CTK has received thousands of dollars from Meijer for our Pantry. Believe us, the need continues greater than ever.

We use gift cards to buy perishables at Meijer for over 70 families/week. We give out staples of milk, bread, cheese, margarine, and eggs. (This is only a fraction of what we give out weekly, as we also provide nonperishables, meat and produce.) Meijer Simply Give campaigns have made this possible for many years.






## **GriefShare**

Happy New Year! A new year means New Year's Resolutions for many people – and I am a person that loves them! Reading the Bible more is maybe the perfect resolution for just about all of us. That will be one of my resolutions this year, and I encourage you to make it one of yours. There may be no other more impactful thing that you can do for your life than being in God's Word more often. I am also a big fan of setting up my New Year's resolutions in a way that they have a good chance of being successful. Here's what I mean: if your resolution is to "read the Bible every single day this year," well, as soon as you miss a day you have failed your resolution, which is discouraging. A better resolution might be: "I will read my Bible 200 times this year." It's the same goal of reading the Bible more, just a different way to look at it. In the first goal, you're always only one day away from failing. With the second goal, you're always adding to your total, moving in a positive direction toward the end result!
