GATHER AND GROW BOOK CLUB





This Month in CTK History

With the beginning of summer and the end of the school year, we first reflect on the history of CTK Day School. In 1959, an outdoor school bell was installed. Also, in 1959, the Board of Christian Education recommended that they purchase a "portable phonograph" for the school!! (Who remembers a "phonograph"?!) The next year, June 1960, the first 8th grade graduation took place, with 9 students. The Day School Class of 1965 was the first class to graduate those students that began in the 1st grade when the school was organized in 1957. Ten of the twenty-one students were in the class throughout all eight years. Four years later, in June 1969, the school celebrated the first Kindergarten graduation.

The BIG events for CTK in June over the years were the Anniversary celebrations. In 1961, a Service of Praise was held for the 10th Anniversary. For the 40th celebration in 1991, there was a special Service and Banquet. Several of the former Pastors attended and participated in the ceremonies. In 2001, CTK celebrated its Golden 50th Anniversary. A "Family Fun Fest" outreach gala was held for the members and community to celebrate and enjoy! We look forward to celebrating our 75th Anniversary next year!!

Adopt-A-Chap

In May, the CTK Programs staff approved a proposal for the CTK Military Ministry to participate in the LCMS Ministry to the Military Adopt-A-Chap Program. As a result, LCMS connected CTK with Chaplain Matthew Mortenson, an Army Major stationed at Fort Leonard Wood in MO. You will see him included in the CTK Intercessions list. A little about him: He is the eldest of nine and the military has played a large role in his family as he has numerous family members who are service members or veterans. He enlisted in the Army out of high school as a Combat Medic, and was in for 6 1/2 years. He got out and went through college, seminary (Concordia, St. Louis), and served a church for almost 6 1/2 years before going back into the Army as a Chaplain. He turned 50 this month. He is a Brigade Chaplain (Major) in the 3rd Chemical BDE. He helps out at a chapel on Post with another LCMS Chaplain (Navy) who takes care of the Marines & Navy Seabees there. He also attends a church off Post and does pulpit supply there from time to time. He is a single dad of 5 daughters. He's had three other assignments before this current one, and all in very different places ranging from armor to airborne. He would appreciate prayers for a very busy and challenging time, as they carry a heavy load doing a lot of training that ranges across a large spectrum (from Basic Combat Training/Boot Camp to specialized schools, or MOS training). For perseverance and endurance to run the race set before him personally. For his kids as they navigate the challenges of school, etc.

Adopt-A-Service Member

In May the Program Staff also approved the Adopt-A-Service Member Program in which congregation members will be paired as prayer partners for our service members. 

The Reformation – is it all about Grace, Faith, or Scripture?

Have you ever heard of the 3 Solas? If not, that's probably because they are Latin phrases, and no one speaks Latin.

Whether you know Latin or not, however, the meaning behind the 3 Sola's is actually vitally important to the life the Christian. The first sola, Sola Gratia, means Grace Alone. This is the idea that all of humanity, every last one of us, has turned away from God. Left to our devices, we would not choose to worship the One True God and worship Him alone. We would all be lost forever if not but by the grace of God, which is given to us through the blood of Jesus, shed for us on Calvary's cross.

The second sola, Sola Fide, means Faith Alone. This means that eternal life is not tied to the good or bad things that you have done, but instead faith in Jesus. Even this faith itself is a work of God, not a work of man.

Sola Scriptura is the third sola. This means Scripture Alone – and this is the idea that the Word of God, the Scriptures, are the only authority of our faith. No writing or person or group of people or tradition get to have authority over what the Bible says.

We very often hear about the 3 Solas in connection with the Reformation – and it got me wondering – which one of these is the most important? You could make a reasonable argument for any of them being the most important one – but maybe the best way to think about it is like this: The most important thing – in fact, the only important thing – is Jesus. Grace Alone is Jesus Alone, because grace is Jesus' life exchanged for mine. Faith Alone is Jesus Alone, because Jesus is the Author and Perfector or our Faith – our Faith is in Him. And Scripture Alone is Jesus Alone – because Jesus is the very Word of God – the Bible is a book that not only tells us about Jesus, and points us to Jesus, it is Jesus. That's why the 3 Solas are important to the Reformation, and why they are important in the life of a Christian – because the 3 Solas are really just 1 Sola – Jesus Alone.

Seminary Update: My next class will be on campus in St. Louis, near the end of June, so I am starting to work to get ready for that! This class is on preaching, and I am very much looking forward to the class itself and also to being on campus once again this summer! 




