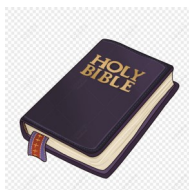

We believe that 1959 will go down in parish history as one of a giant forward step..." -- Pastor Biesenthal, original pastor of CTK.

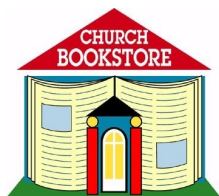
"...one copy of each Sunday bulletin will be saved. Years from now, our file of Sunday bulletins will help supply historical data for our church's history." - September 1951

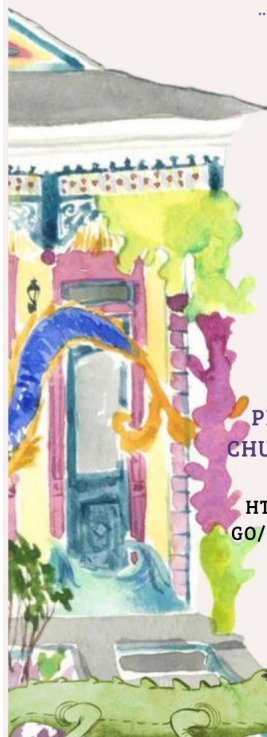

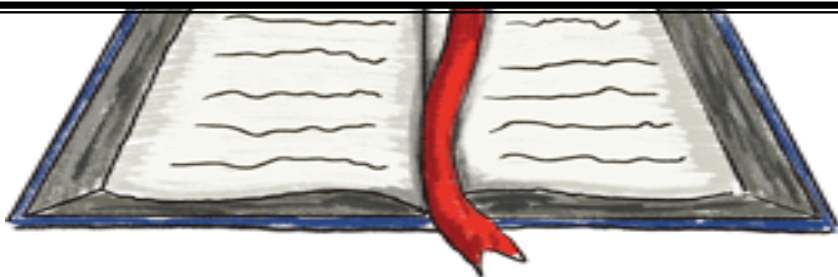

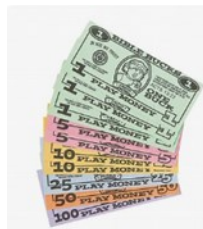
Did you Know?

Pastor's Message



*God's truth will
always win
over Satan's lies.*

You know how much I love history. So, I'm thinking, "2025 is a nice round number, could be the Quarter Quell in some circles. I wonder what the buzz was 100 years ago."

In July of 1925, America was captivated by the "Scopes Trial" in Dayton, Tennessee. Also called "The Scopes Monkey Trial" this was one of the most important legal battles of its time. Two of the greatest speakers of the era, Clarence Darrow and William Jennings Bryan, faced off in a debate encompassing science, religion, and Constitutional rights. Granted, the whole thing was a set-up to challenge the Tennessee state law banning the teaching of evolution in public schools. John T. Scopes, a high school science teacher, volunteered to be the patsy. He said he couldn't remember if he actually taught evolution, but did remember going through the chapter on it! For two weeks, the religions of evolution and creation went toe to toe. The High Priest of evolution, Clarence Darrow, outperformed William Jennings Bryan, mainly because the science of creation was in its infancy. Even though Scopes was found guilty, evolution won the popular vote and began its entrenchment in American culture. The great irony is this: Darrow used faith, faith in evolution guised in science, better than Bryan. About 35 years later, Henry Morris and John Whitcomb would use actual science with evidence to begin modern creationism, which demonstrates a young earth. In the 100 years since the Scopes trial, evolution has produced literally zero observational science to support its religion and creation science has exploded exponentially! God is like that, the truth always wins!
