PASTOR TERRY'S HEALTH UPDATE

Dear Friends,

Many of you have been praying for Pastor Terry and our family, and we are so grateful for this outpouring of love and concern. As of July 22nd, Pastor has undergone two weeks of daily radiation, and two sessions of chemotherapy to address early-stage bladder cancer. The prognosis for this treatment is a 66% cure rate.

In addition to the cancer, Pastor is suffering from advanced COPD, which further complicates treatment. It is the COPD that has compromised so much of his life, as sometimes even talking is not possible. Consequently, he goes to church early, sits in the balcony, and leaves early, as he just does not have the breath to talk to friends.

The cancer treatment will be completed in five weeks. Our prayer request is that his COPD will not inhibit this treatment, that at the end of treatment he gets a good report, is able to gain some weight, and then concentrate on dealing with his COPD.

Hopefully this will answer most of your questions, and give you direction for prayers. Pastor Terry is truly at peace with what's going on, and knows that whatever happens is in God's perfect will.
