

As we turn the calendar toward a new year, I'm excited to share that Christ The King will be launching a renewed and expanded Small Group Ministry. For many in our church family, this


# Already Set For Christmas

# Pastor's Message

"Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the east came to Jerusalem, saying, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star when it rose



and have come to worship him." Matt. 2:1-2. There is more unknown than known about the wise men. We don't know their number; we assume three because of the gifts. We don't know the timing—the when. We assume after Jesus' presentation at the temple, forty days after his birth, and before his second birthday. That's a big window! We don't exactly know where they are from. If I told you I was expecting company "from the East," that could be anywhere East of I-75! This is my primary question about the wise man: "What prompted them to travel?" I know they saw the star, but that's a long, arduous trip. Hundreds of miles. Months of travel. Significant expense. No guarantee you'll find the "him" of "his star when it rose." What is their motivation to seek the "king of the Jews." Could it be as simple as the wise men embody the spirit in all of us yearning for meaning? Created in the image of God we even as sinful beings—search for God's image. God's image is found in the miracle we celebrate this time of year: The Incarnation. "The Word became flesh, and made His dwelling among us." (John 1:14)
